The Airspeed Indicator operating markings must be changed due to a higher stall speed as indicated in the FAA Flight Supplement #1 page 2.1 - FAA 4 Dec. 02. This can be done by taping on the new operating range decals on the face of the instrument, or by purchasing a new Airspeed Indicator from AMD, part number 20-M-96-1/0.

Operating range decals can be purchased from Aircraft Spruce & Specialty Co., 1-877-477-7823, and part number 10-03905 for about \$2.95/set.

Complete weight & Balance form in the FAA Flight Supplement #1 page 6.3 - FAA 4 Dec. 02 and put in aircraft with other required documentation. Update Airframe Log Book.
